



Grants for Organisations

Purpose

Magnify Foundation is seeking to support organisations that focus on 'advancing the Christian faith'; seeing Kingdom growth and transformation through all kinds of outreach.

Who can apply for this grant?

Registered charities, social enterprise schemes including community interest companies or cooperatives, or a charitable organisation.

What are grants available for?

Grants are available for organisations that meet a community need with a focus on bringing about Kingdom transformation.

For example, the grant could enable the organisation to expand its operations, employ staff, extend its reach, or establish its roots and facilitate growth. These are just suggestions, and if there is a dream that God has put on the organisation's heart that meets a need, then Magnify would encourage an application.

How much are the grants?

There are no set minimum or maximum limits, although we'd normally expect a project to need a minimum of £10,000 grant funding. The grants could be paid over two or three years.

How are grants paid?

Successful applicants may apply for, and receive, a one-off grant; or staged funding released at appropriate points during the project timeline, in line with key milestones that you identify in your planning.

Growth can take time to deliver well, and we anticipate a two or three year commitment for substantial grants.

Is there a financial contribution expected from the organisation or organisations involved?

If your organisation has plentiful unrestricted reserves, it's unlikely to be successful in its application. On the other hand, Magnify are keen that the organisation's existing financial commitments are not jeopardised by being diverted into a fund purely to demonstrate its dedication to the project. Some financial details about the organisation will be requested as part of the application.

What are the criteria?

Applications need to show:

- what the need is that the organisation seeks to meet,
- how the organisation brings good news and kingdom transformation,
- the organisation's outcomes: the change in the community expected because of its work.

You will be asked to detail some short-term and longer-term goals and aims, and we'll need some details of how this will be worked towards and measured along the way.

Are there any projects that cannot be funded?

Not necessarily, as Magnify want to encourage imaginative and innovative gospel projects, so will consider any project that seeks to meet a community need, with a focus on bringing about Kingdom transformation.

Please note that if your application includes a capital expenditure buildings or property project, then we'll need to see how it directly relates to seeing Kingdom transformation and change; and at which point in your timeline it becomes necessary to continue achieving those outcomes.

How are applications made?

Applications will be submitted online via Microsoft Forms.

There is no submission deadline for applications.

On receipt of a completed application, The Trustees will then consider, and aim to notify applicants of the outcome within eight weeks.

Please put as much detail as possible into the application as you can to help inform the Trustees' decision.
