

Grants for Individuals

Purpose

Magnify Foundation is seeking to support individuals who are 'advancing the Christian faith'; seeing Kingdom growth and transformation through all kinds of outreach.

Who can apply for this grant?

Individuals who are seeking support to enable their involvement in a Christian faith venture.

What are grants available for?

Grants are available for individuals who are bringing about Kingdom transformation, and meeting a community need.

For example, the grant could enable you to expand your operations, or enable you to become bi-vocational. These are just suggestions, and if there is a dream that God has put on your heart that meets a need, Magnify would encourage an application.

How much are the grants?

There are no set minimum or maximum limits, although we'd normally expect an individual grant to be in the region of £6000 per year. This figure is just a guide, please request what you need on the form.

How are grants paid?

Successful applicants may apply for, and receive, a one-off grant; monthly, or annual payments. This will be assessed when your application is considered by the Trustees, and may depend on any key milestones in your planning.

What are the criteria?

Applications need to show:

- what the need is that the venture you are involved in seeks to meet,
- how this brings good news and kingdom transformation,
- your involvement and what you hope to do

You will be asked to detail some short-term key steps you want to take, and any longer-term goals you may have.

Is there anything that cannot be funded?

Not necessarily, as Magnify want to encourage imaginative and innovative gospel projects, so will consider applications from individuals with a focus on bringing about Kingdom



transformation, and meeting a community need. All grants must meet our charitable objects – we are not permitted to make grants that fall outside of these.

How are applications made?

Applications are submitted online, using the form that can be found by clicking <u>here</u>, or by scanning the QR code.



There is no submission deadline for applications.

On receipt of a completed application, the Trustees will then consider, and aim to notify applicants of the outcome within eight weeks.

Please put as much detail as possible into the application as you can to help inform the Trustees' decision.
